We as a committee want to thank everyone who supported SEAZNAC I. Everyone who was able to attend made the weekend what it was. Thank you to the groups that helped in the Hospitality Suite and donated Basic Texts. You guys are great.

Last year we submitted guidelines to the ASC. Although the committee should bring forward any ideas or recommendations, it is not a guideline writing committee. We also suggest the Area reviews and adopts these guidelines.

We as a committee look forward to electing our new trusted servants, and believe this should take place as stated in our *Drafted Guidelines*. This will allow next year's committee to move forward. The sooner we elect a new committee, the sooner they can get started planning next year.

Keep in mind it has only been a week since the convention. Our books are still open. We still have some outstanding transactions. Therefore, this is not a final and complete accounting of the money. When all transactions have been posted to the account, then we will conduct the audit with our Area Treasurer Leslea J., as per our Drafted guidelines.

We started with **\$2,500.00** seed money from the Area.

We brought in **\$34,212.87** total to date.

We spent **\$20,702.46** total to date.

Which is a profit of **\$13,510.41** to date.

Our current bank balance is **\$16,263.41**.

Our committee suggests we keep **\$5000.00** to seed SEAZNAC II. We believe our fundraising was off the hook, as was our pre-convention merchandise sales. To expect that kind of enthusiasm again next year may be unrealistic. We also believe we need a larger venue for next year, which will probably cost more. After all, that is the amount the Arizona Region denied us last year.
