SEAZNA TREASURER:

Hello Family,

This is the final month of our fiscal year and I have been going over bank statements, NAWS invoices, Area minutes and my excel spread sheets to ensure an accurate finial report. I have some curious findings this fiscal year I thought might interest our Fellowship;

- 7th Tradition has gone down from an average of \$952.20 to \$788.32
- The average literature order went up from \$1438.33 to \$2020.
- The average literature sales went up from \$1020 to \$1211.
- Regional donations went from \$500 to \$900 (This month is the finial odd month to review another donation).

Budget Review is in August and ASC and subcommittees are required to turn in a budget. When the budgets are prepared, please indicated which month the money needed will be used. Copies of last year's budget requests are posted on our website in the Forms and Guidelines page. To help the Subcommittee chairs, both outgoing and incoming, I have these figures to help with your 2016/2017 budgets:

- Activities spent \$1,358.93 and returned \$1858.07.
- H&I spent \$429.42 (not including their literature orders) and returned \$100
- Literature spent \$122 in supplies.
- Phone line spent \$891.44 for phone service and nothing else.
- Public Relations spent \$1906.68 and will need an additional \$850 in their budget to cover the Bus Shelter Project with Advision who will no longer be splitting payments for us.
- Executive Committee spent \$2,447.03 which includes rent, P.O. Boxes, Regional donations and more

SEAZNA I funds, I named Special Projects Fund has these numbers for your viewing pleasure:

- Prudent reserved was raised from \$500 to \$1,100.
- To Correctional Facilities went \$4,756.68
- To PR spent \$601.39
- Outreach has donated literature to Mexico but the exact value is unknown. They were allotted \$300 so we can just figure they spent \$300.

A grand total of \$6,758.35, from \$8,932 leaves \$2,173.65 left unspent. The unspent money comes from:

- \$500 Literature
- \$898.61 PR
- \$787.32 H&I

A grand total of \$2185.93 unspent Special Project Funds remain one year after our convention. The funds from SEAZNAC II is soon to arrive. Meanwhile our Area is \$100 into our prudent reserve. I recommend we give those committees one more month to use the unspent funds or be absorbed into our SEAZNA area.
