The meeting is Monday at 6:00 - 7:00pm near Catalina AZ. If interested, please come to H&I the 2nd Sunday of the month at 12:30. We carried the message to 1,378 addicts this month thru H&I.

LITERATURE:

On August 14, 2016 the literature sales to Area GSR,s was \$1,616.08 This month we spent \$2,104.51 to maintain our inventory of approximately \$2,500.00. The cost this month to support H & I Literature was \$262.80 Our freight charge this month from NA World was \$155.89, after receiving our less discount of \$124.38 that reduced our freight charge to only\$31.51.

MT LEMON BASH:

PHONE LINE:

In August 2016, phone line received 171 calls, 18 were forwarded to a phone line volunteer. We are in need of more volunteers, particularly for the morning shift.
