My sponsor (who is the definition of amazing) had me write letters, the first one being to myself and the freedom that came out of writing that letter to myself and believing in my soul that I deserved that self forgiveness...it was time to give myself a break and to be able to live, let be and let go. One of the most significant amends I had to make was to my mom who passed away several years ago to breast cancer. I've shared this multiple times on how angry, resentful and bitter I was to her and how much I beat myself up on how because of my addiction I couldn't be present for her like she deserved but through working these steps I have learned what it truly means to make living amends. My mom's passion was advocating and showing up for women in recovery and today I GET to do that and through my higher power and NA Im clean and am productive and that's all it is. To me this step is about having freedom not just from others but from self. It has taken me a lot sponsor guidance, sharing in meetings and lots of authentic prayer to get there. I carried so much weight and self hate from the choices I have made but because of this program and step work on the daily I learn how to practice the spiritual principles of love, forgiveness and willingness.
